Joint Special Power of Attorney

For two or more applicants authorizing a representative to act on their behalf for any legal transaction/s.

Requirements:

- 1. Personal appearance of applicants;
- 2. Duly accomplished <u>Special Power of Attorney</u> form needed to be notarized;
- 3. One (1) copy for the Embassy of the said document;
- 4. Passport copies of applicants depending on the number of document/s needed to be notarized and one (1) passport copy for the Embassy file; and
- 5. Any valid Philippine Government issued ID of representative, number of copies depending on the document needed to be notarized and one (1) copy for the Embassy file.
